
CHARACTER DESIGNS

I was inspired by the quote, ***be a bad girl like me, and you'll get somewhere*** by the honorable Millie Odhiambo.


She's also a gang leader in a corrupt political environment.




BODYGUARD

I love Aya of Yopougon, so a lot of my work contains references to the comic. I don't have a story for these characters yet, but they were fun to create.





COMMISSIONS!



This was my very first webcomic. I struggled while making it, but it turned out to be a great first lesson. I've since taken it down, but I plan to redo the comic in a print layout.

ONE PANEL DIARIES





DIARY CONCEPT




PRELIMINARY SKETCHES

The paper speech bubbles were a happy accident, and I plan on using them for the One Panel Diaries concept. They were my favorite part to work on.




